Race Report for CORR Round 1, April 22, 2007, Antelope Valley Fairgrounds Raceway

Team Monster Energy Potawatomi Toyota Kicks off 2007 With A Trip West and Another Trip to Victory Lane

Johnny Greaves picked up where he left off with an exciting win in round one of the Pro-4 class here at Antelope Valley Fairgrounds. Greaves led the race from beginning to end without relinquishing the lead.
